## Marlborough Rural East NPT

Welcome to February's edition of the Neighbourhood policing team bulletin.

In the last bulletin I explained about the current running priorities that we have in our area. Myself together with my colleagues at Marlborough have paid attention to traffic in the Baydon area with no problems being uncovered or reported.

I have been made aware that the local school is having building work carried out and during this period could upset the parking for parents picking up and dropping off at the school. I urge all parents and residents to adhere to the law when finding suitable places to park their vehicles and not to cause any unnecessary obstructions.

Anti-social behaviour patrols have been carried out in Ramsbury and Aldbourne and have been a success with no reports of criminal damage or vandalism being found or reported.

These priorities will be kept open until March when new priorities will be set.

The next two surgeries will be held in February by myself and I urge people to come along to discuss any concerns they may have in relation to our area that the police could help with. The priorities are set from

information received from the surgeries and reports from residents. The dates are as follows:

- Aldbourne Library Police Surgery - February 8<sup>th</sup> at 6pm till 6:45pm
- Ramsbury Library Police Surgery - February 8<sup>th</sup> at 7pm till 7:45pm.

I would also like to make people aware of a large amount of rural thefts that have taken place over the past 2 weeks in Wiltshire and particularly over the east Wiltshire border with Thames Valley. There have been a number of trailer thefts and Landrover thefts. Please be vigilant in reporting suspicious activity to the police especially in rural locations. Marlborough officers and the rural crime team officers have changed shifts to work nights to try and prevent more of these crimes occurring.

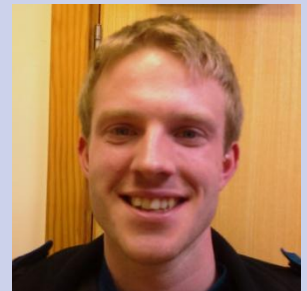
