Welcome to the latest edition of the Neighbourhood policing team bulletin. A happy new year to you all.

I would like to make everyone aware of our current running priorities for the area.

- Traffic related issues in Baydon -Parents dropping children off at Baydon Primary School are parking inconsiderately and causing an obstruction. This, combined with speeding vehicles in Ermin street directly outside the school, causes danger during school drop off and pick up times.
- Anti-Social Behaviour in Aldbourne specifically Westfield Chase and Whitley playing field areas.

These three priorities were set as a result of information received by the community during surgeries held in Ramsbury and Aldbourne libraries in 2009.

These priorities are managed by the Neighbourhood policing team at Marlborough and other local officers.

Aldbourn:

02/01/2010 - Theft of Gas Oil from a business unit.
