

Heads Up!

We are delighted to welcome everyone back to the new school year and make a particular welcome to our new Reception children who have settled in to school life really quickly and feel as if they've always been with us.

We have started the term with our whole school topic 'In the Deep, Dark Woods' which we use as a stimulus for learning across the curriculum. It is a pleasure to see children already being enthused and engaged in stories about the Deep, Dark Woods and what life would have been like in Stone Age times.

The children have been delighted with the launch of our lunchtime initiative: Playpod. The concept behind Playpod is to give children the opportunity to play with a range of recycled materials including cardboard boxes, drapes, ropes, tubing, dressing up clothes, old keyboards etc. and enabling them to use their creativity and imagination to play. As well as having fun, children develop critical skills such as co-operation, resilience and learn to manage their own risk. All our lunchtime supervisors have been fully trained and the children are loving their lunchtime play.

Our School Councillors and House Captains have been elected and School Council is working on a project for breaktime play. This year, our House Captains are each going to be responsible for organizing a Charity Day for their House. Congratulations to Evie, Juno and Euan for successfully organising the first for Newton House and raising over £150 for the charity Jeans for Genes. All children came to school dressed in a pair of jeans and donated cakes for a very successful sale!

As part of our healthy schools initiative which we are working on this year, the children enjoyed a morning of workshops led by a practitioner from the Great Western Hospital learning about the importance of keeping their teeth clean and not eating too much sugar.

We also invited the NSPCC into school to work with the children on their 'Speak Out Stay Safe Programme', the main message of which was that children need to know that they have a right to stay safe and should talk to a trusted adult if they have any concerns. A difficult subject but brilliantly delivered across the school by staff from the NSPCC.

Swindon Music Co-operative joined us for a Worship where they enthused the children about playing a brass instrument and we all much enjoyed listening to some music and having a turn. We are now able to offer brass lessons in addition to guitar, piano and drumming,

Over the course of the summer holidays, we have installed a brand new boiler and, most excitingly, brand new toilets in the main building. Although we were successful in bids to the Diocese for these two projects, the school is responsible for finding 10% of the costs and our thanks go to all those who have supported us in our endeavours. The Ramsbury Flyer Community Bus

The Ramsbury 'Flyer' is run by volunteers within the village of Ramsbury and other local communities. It has been in existence since 1993. Ramsbury Community Transport, which operates The Flyer, became a registered charity in 2014. The 'Flyer' provides reasonably priced transport for all ages and is used by local clubs and societies as well as for regular scheduled services. On our scheduled shopping services, bus passes can be used.

The day to day costs of running the Flyer are paid for by the grants from local authorities, donations and revenue from private and community hire.

The aim of the Flyer is to provide affordable and convenient transport to the residents of Ramsbury and surrounding villages, complimenting other forms of public transport.

We have a number of regular services, which include:

- **Transport to and from the Ramsbury Surgery - Tuesday & Thursday mornings** The Flyer visits local villages, including Ramsbury, Baydon, Aldbourne, Axford, Mildenhall, Froxfield and Chilton Foliat, picking up residents at a central place and taking them to and from the Ramsbury Surgery for their appointments. In order to use this free service, simply mention this to the Receptionist when booking your appointment at the Surgery.
- **Scheduled service to Hungerford - Wednesday & Friday mornings. See Flyer Scheduled Services Timetable on our website and displayed in bus shelters - Bus passes can be used**
- **Wednesday:** shopping trip to Hungerford, collecting from Ramsbury, Chilton Foliat and Froxfield.
- **Friday:** shopping trip to Hungerford, collecting from Aldbourne, Ramsbury and Froxfield
- **Scheduled service to Marlborough – 1st and 3rd Wednesday of the month. See Flyer Scheduled Services Timetable on our website and displayed in bus shelters - Bus passes can be used**
- **Newbury shopping Excursion - 2nd Thursday each month.** Regular excursion into Newbury leaves the square in Ramsbury at 11.30am. You can be collected from Back Lane, Axford, Ramsbury High Street and Aldbourne – this is not a scheduled service so bus passes cannot be accepted. The current fare £4.00. Please phone Janet on 01672 520682 to reserve your place

The 'Flyer' can also be hired to community organisations and private individuals at very competitive rates. See our website for more information – www.ramsburyflyer.org .

Historical photos of the BYPA

Continuing our articles about the history of the BYPA in Baydon, we are delighted to print here some pictures of the erecting of the previous building on the BYPA site. In 1976 the only thing on the site was a concrete plinth and a solitary white toilet. Not long afterwards Roger Forster and Roy Canning obtained a wooden building from Bedford that had originally been a farm chicken shed, and this was erected on this plinth. A set of steps led from Manor Lane up the right-hand side of the land to this Hut, and a youth club was started, run by an activities committee. Unfortunately, some time later, during the period between Christmas and New Year, the wooden hut was burnt down.


